A. Dairy Units with 25% Subsidy

- 1. Subsidy 25% of the Unit Cost on Livestock Purchase will be provided.
- 2. Subsidy will be provided for Dairy Units of 4 & 10 Milch Animals Dairy Unit.
- 3. Subsidy will be provided in LOAN account of beneficiary.
- 4. Margin Money would be as per Bank Requirement.
- 5. Insurance premium shall be paid by the beneficiary (in case if no Govt. Schemes).
- 6. Any applicant who has earlier availed benefit under any Departmental Scheme for establishment of livestock unit would not be eligible for availing benefit under the Scheme.

(i) Eligibility conditions for an Applicant:-

- 1. The applicant should be unemployed of 18 to 60 years of age, a resident of Haryana. (employment even in private sector would not be eligible.)
- 2. The applicant should provide unemployment certificate by the way undertaking that he/she not working at any Government Department / Corporation / Board /

- University etc and to abide by other conditions as required under the Scheme. The applicant should have space/ shed for keeping milch animals.
- 3. For 20 Milch and 50 Milch animals dairy unit, Applicant must have 2 Acres and 5 Acres Agriculture Land respectively either by way of Ownership or Long lease.
- 4. Educational Qualifications is not mandatory.
- 5. Any group/ firm/ organization would not be permitted to apply under the Scheme, as the Scheme being an individual beneficiary oriented.
- 6. A beneficiary will be eligible to re-apply for loan again for any Departmental Scheme after a gap of 7 year from the date of disbursement and an affidavit in this regard also be provided by the applicant. Similarly, the Spouse of beneficiary will not be eligible to apply for any above mentioned Departmental Scheme for next 7 years. However, the beneficiary may be eligible to upgrade his/her Livestock Unit to larger Unit by applying for 20/50 MA only.

(iii) Agreement

- 1. Applicant will submit an **Agreement** in case of 20 and 50 MA Dairy Unit after sanction of loan by bank.
- 2. The SDO (AH&D) would sign the Agreement under his hand and seal (Annexure-I). You may download it from www.drnain.com given at Sr. No. 756.

(iv) Selection of Applicant

- 1. DD will accept/ reject the applications and will forward valid applications to SDO within a period of three days.
- 2. SDO will sent the valid applications to banks within 3 days (Annexure II). You may download it from www.drnain.com given at Sr. No. 757.
- 3. SDO will receive the SANCTION LETTER from the bank and will upload on SARAL PORTAL, and will forward to DD.
- 4. DD will allow for purchase of animals.
- 5. After getting approval from DD, SDO will prepare a PURCHASE Letter (having Date, Time and Venue of Purchase and will intimate to Purchase Committee and Applicant. i.e. Annexure III, You may download it from www.drnain.com given at Sr. No. 758.

6. The purchase will be in two parts in ratio of 50:50 subject to the condition that the second purchase shall have to be effected within one year from the date of first purchase but preferably within same financial year.

(vi) Insurance and Margin Money

- 1. Insurance premium shall be paid by the beneficiary (in case if no Govt. Schemes).
- 2. **Interest Subvention** will be provided for Dairy Units of 20 & 50 Milch Animals Dairy Units, preferably **Half-yearly/ Annually** for **5 Years** in LOAN account of beneficiary.
- 3. Margin Money would be 25% of the total unit cost.
- 4. Maximum Cost of Unit will be Rs 20 Lakh and 50 Lakh for 20MA and 50MA dairy units respectively.
- 5. Maximum Limit of Loan amount for Interest Subvention as 75% of Total i.e. Rs. 15 Lakh and 37.50 Lakh for 20MA and 50MA dairy units respectively.
- 6. Beneficiary would repay EMI monthly.

(vii) CONDITIONS for Interest Subvention:-

Now the parties hereby agree as follows:-

- 1. Assistance in the form of interest subvention on interest amount on loan availed by the applicant from bank for purchase of milch animals for establishment of Dairy Unit will be provided by the Government for five years and the quantum of such assistance would be strictly as per the provisions of the Scheme.
- 2. The purchase cost of animals shall be determined as per the provisions mentioned in the Scheme.
- 3. Assistance amount will be provided to the beneficiary by the Government preferably half yearly or annually for five years. The Department would make every effort to release the instalment of assistance amount within one month from the date it becomes due. In certain unavoidable circumstances like non-availability of budget, the release of assistance amount may be got delayed and in such cases the applicant shall have no legal right to initiate any legal action against the Government.
- 4. The interest subsidy would become payable subject to the production of a certificate from the concerned Bank and physical verification of the Dairy Unit as per the provisions of the Scheme.
- 5. The applicant shall:-
 - (a) furnish such periodical reports as may be called from time to time by the Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Haryana or his/her representative authorized by him/her in this behalf.
 - (b) maintain separate accounts of the financial assistance paid to him/her and Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Haryana shall have the right to check himself or through his authorized representative these accounts and the connected record etc.
 - (c) repay within a period of 5 years the amount of the loan taken from Bank for the purchase of milch animals.
 - (d) get the milch animals ear tagged as a mark of identification and insured.
 - (e) intimate forthwith the death or theft or sale or replacement of the milch animals to the Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department of the concerned district or his/her authorised representative and also to bank/financial institution which has financed the Dairy Unit.

- (f) purchase the milch animals through Purchase Committee mentioned in the Scheme.
- (g) faithfully comply with the advice of the Department as to the management, feeding, vaccinations, breeding, recording of the livestock and shall abide by all the provisions as required under the Scheme.
- (h) shall be liable to return all the financial assistance provided by the Department and shall stand debarred from any financial assistance under any other Scheme being implemented by the Department in future, if, at any stage it is noticed by the Department that the applicant has violated any terms and conditions of the Scheme or has provided wrong information.
- 6. If any dispute / difference arise between the parties hereto during the subsistence of this Agreement or thereafter, such dispute shall be referred to Arbitration. Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying Haryana, Panchkula will be the arbitrator for any dispute. The place of Arbitration shall be at Panchkula. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to this Agreement.
